ROMANS TRANSFORMATION

INTRODUCTION

Romans 12:1-18 gives us a clear picture how we as Christians can be transformed and, in turn, reach out to transform the world around us. The church creates disciples who, transformed by the Holy Spirit, are infiltrating today's culture on a local and global scale.

When we establish a relationship with Jesus Christ and begin applying His principles, we experience a transformed life. This process results in community. As community serves others, transformation has an impact on our world. Transformation redefines the focus and practice of the church and changes the character of its people to mirror the character of Jesus.

DISCUSSION STARTER

1. Tell the group about a less than stellar decision you made, that at the time you made it, seemed like the right thing to do?
2. Why is humility a key to being a Christ-Follower? How can a lack of humility hinder one's growth as a believer?

EVALUATE IT

1. Read Romans 12:1-2? What does it mean to be a living sacrifice? How does that compare to a typical sacrifice?
2. What does it mean to conform to something? How do believers conform to the patterns of the world?
3. How do we renew our minds? What does that look like? How does that lead to transformation?
4. How does being a living sacrifice, not conforming to the world and renewing our mind lead to knowing God's will?

MAKE IT PERSONAL

1. Jason's friend Phillip attends AA meetings and his parents went to counseling for months. What do you need to be doing to renew your mind and let God transform you?
2. How can God use your transformation to impact another for the Kingdom?
