# ROMANS TRANSFORMATION

## INTRODUCTION

Old trucks, old shoes and old jeans have more in common than just being old. They're comfortable and we don't like the process of changing them. We get used to air conditioners blowing hot air, wet feet when it rains and pockets with holes. We resist and delay until it becomes painfully obvious something needs to change. But once we make a change, it's amazing how quickly we start liking cold air on a hot day, dry feet and change in our pockets.

God is working, making us aware when change is needed and helping us find new comfort in our new lives.

## DISCUSSION STARTER

1. Tell the group about a transformational moment in your life that has greatly affected who you are now.
2. Who has been a transformational person in your life? Why?

## EVALUATE IT

1. Chris said, "God loves me just as I am but He's not willing to let me stay that way. He wants to transform me." Why is this? Why does God want to transform us?
2. Read Romans 1:16-17. What reasons does Paul give for not being ashamed of the Gospel?
3. Chris referenced the story found in Mark 5:1-20 where Jesus heals a demon-possessed man. Why does the healed man follow Jesus' instructions with joy, yet the people of the town ask Jesus to leave? Why the contrasting responses to this miracle of Jesus?

1. Do you resist transformation and change? Why or why not?
2. In what areas of your life could you use some transformation? Why?
