INTRODUCTION

Engage is all about fulfilling Jesus' command to us recorded in Matthew 28:19-20. The ability to engage starts when we understand the true meaning of being a disciple. Discipleship is the process of helping people know Jesus more and obey all He has commanded. Jesus tells His people to be about the business of not only making new disciples, but also making current disciples better disciples. The hope at FCC is that we will actively engage in praying for opportunities to share the Gospel with lost friends and neighbors and thus, lost people will recognize their need, repent and believe.

DISCUSSION STARTER

EVALUATE IT

1. Read Colossians 1:15-22. What is Jesus' relationship to God and the church? What does fullness imply (v. 19)?
2. Why did all things need to be reconciled to God (v. 20)? How was this achieved by Jesus?
3. How much do you identify with verse 21, even now?
4. What emotions stir within you when you read verse 22? Why?

MAKE IT PERSONAL

1. Even though Jesus is over everything, what people (or forces) seem to be more powerful than Jesus in your life? Why?
2. FCC has many areas such as worship, children, youth, local missions, foreign missions, life groups, etc. Have those willing in your group pick an area of the church and close your group time by praying for every facet of FCC.
