Hebrews 10:19-22

## INTRODUCTION

Each week at FCC we meet together as believers in Jesus to receive the Word of God and to worship Him. Corporate worship brings together God's word, prayer and fellowship, thus making for the greatest means of God's ongoing grace in our Christian lives.

Scripture is full of reasons we must worship. Romans 12:1 says, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship." May we always immerse ourselves in worship to God not just on Sundays but daily.

## DISCUSSION STARTER

1. Tell the group about a thank you card you have received that meant a lot to you. Why was it so valuable to you?
2. When you hear someone mention the word worship, what comes to mind? What is worship?

## EVALUATE IT

1. Stuart explained that worship is a thank you letter to Jesus. How so? How is worship a thank you letter to Jesus?
2. Read Hebrews 10:19-23. How do we enter the Most Holy Place with confidence and by what means is this even possible? How is this different from the worship experience of pre-Christ worshippers of God?
3. Stuart explained that we should come to worship prepared. What does it look like to come to worship prepared? What are some practical things we can do to prep for worship?
4. What does it mean to be reverent? Stuart said, we still approach with reverence. What does that look like and why is it right to approach with reverence?

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

1. Stuart asked, "How well are you preparing for what you're about to write during a time of worship?" How well are you preparing for worship? What is on your mind on a typical Sunday when you arrive for worship?
2. Do you feel comfortable coming to God with confidence? Explain.
